#### 5. Weekly Markets

- a) Pursuant to Standing Order 7a, to resolve to recommend to Town Council that the following resolutions are reversed:
  - I. the Wednesday market should give priority to stalls that wholly or mainly sell fresh food or plant products;
- II. from 1<sup>st</sup> August 2024, the principle of making a charge for a stall be reintroduced, with an additional charge for a stall exceeding a defined standard width, given the limited space in Fromus Square;
- III. stalls wholly or mainly selling fresh food or plant products should for the time being continue to be exempt from such charge, such exemption to be reviewed in early 2025.
- b) To review and resolve to recommend to Town Council that it approves the draft Market Regulations for the weekly markets.
- c) To consider reintroducing stallage charges for all traders at the weekly markets from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2024 and resolve to recommend the decision to Town Council.
- d) To consider whether to introduce a policy for types of traders at the weekly markets and resolve to recommend the decision to Town Council.
- e) To receive a progress update on the 'Friends of the Wednesday Markets' initiative.

To review and resolve to recommend to Town Council that it approves the draft Market Regulations for the monthly markets.
